SIB Awards honour bioinformatics excellence in three categories:

- **Early Career Bioinformatics Award** – an international award to recognise the excellence and promising nature of a researcher's early career, based on one or several projects and/or papers focussing on the *in silico* analysis of biological sequences, structures or processes.
